Character Quality: Repentance – To feel sorry about doing something wrong and not doing it again.

Family Follow Up

Read Genesis 27 as a family. Point out to your child the fact that Jacob got what he wanted in the end, but he had to leave his family. He couldn't be with them while his brother was so angry with him. He alienated himself because of his selfishness. Next time your child thinks about lying or doing something to ensure that she gets what she wants, encourage her to think again and remember the story of Jacob and the price he paid for what he did. Is what they want worth the risk of hurting a friend or family member?
